On 24 and 25 February 2022, in the framework of the French Presidency of the Council of the European Union, we will be honoured to welcome you to the Palais du Luxembourg – the home of the Senate of the French Republic – for the meeting of the Interparliamentary Conference for the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) and the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP), which will be held as an actual physical meeting for the first time since the Zagreb conference of 3 and 4 March 2020.
