The French Presidency of the Council of the European Union will open in January next year against a backdrop of multiple challenges facing the European Union.

Internally, the European Union must find a way out of the pandemic, build its resilience and revitalise its economy, while simultaneously ensuring its ecological transition, overseeing its digital transformation and safeguarding the rule of law. Externally, the European Union must protect its borders whilst upholding its values and adopting a geopolitical position that promotes strategic autonomy and facilitates partnership building with third countries.

Launched in spring 2021, the Conference on the Future of Europe aims to outline responses to these challenges by building a dialogue with European citizens.
